Mollusca is the second largest phylum of invertebrate animals. The members are known as molluscs or mollusks (/ ˈ ɛ ː m ɛ ˈ l ɪ ɛ ʃ k /). Around 85,000 extant species of molluscs are recognized. The number of fossil species is estimated between 60,000 and 100,000 additional species. Molluscs are the largest marine phylum, comprising about 23% of all the named marine organisms.

ABSTRACT. Feed influences directly growth and survival in land snails. Here, we investigate the influence of diet and isolation on growth and survival in *Bulimulus tenuissimus* (d'Orbigny, 1835) in the laboratory. Animals were maintained individually and in groups and three different types of diets: lettuce, ration and both lettuce and ration (mixed diet) for 210 days.
